- ✓ Document environmental or occupational, socio-economic and developmental factors as well as health financing policies having negative or positive effects on the identified problem

# REGULATIONS AND PROCEDURES

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- ✓ Work on an interventional project to improve the chosen community health regarding the identified problem
- ✓ The project has to combine public health knowledge in general and skills gained throughout all modules covered by this field placement
- ✓ Conduct a need assessment= **DATA COLLECTION**
- ✓ Conduct a stakeholder analysis
